

Home Run Ministries Elementary Academy For Students in Grades 3-5 (updated 3/25/2021)

HRM Elementary Academy is a partnership education program where students learn from a qualified teacher in a classroom setting one day a week, while the parents reinforce the learning experience with guided lessons during the week. Grades are not given, but teachers will assist the parents in determining mastery and evaluating progress.

Morning Program - Math Skills, Writing and Grammar, and Critical Thinking. Each class is 60 minutes. The classes are divided into learning groups based on age and class prerequisites.

Group A - ages 7-10 (corresponds to 3rd grade)

Group B - ages 9-11 (corresponds to 4th grade)

Group C - ages 10-12* (corresponds to 5th grade)

Afternoon Program - Science/ History/Literature Unit Study - This 120 minute class provides instruction in science, world history and literature using experiments, hands-on activities, and dynamic group interaction. Classes are for students ages 7-12.

*Fifth graders having participated in the Writing and Math courses may, with teacher recommendation, be exempt from the Math Interview and the English Placement upon registering for Basic English and Beginning Math in HRM Secondary Academy. Fifth grade English students entering the Secondary Academy the following year may also be exempt from the HRM Writing Boot Camp.

All classes may be taken a-la-carte or as an entire program of study. Classes are held on Tuesdays over 30 weeks.
